

Postdoctoral position: Behavioural ecology of vervet monkey thermoregulation

The Brain Function Research Group at the University of the Witwatersrand, South Africa, and the Barrett-Henzi lab at the University of Lethbridge, Canada are conducting a long-term study on the behavioural ecology of vervet monkey thermoregulation. This project, under the directorship of Associate Professor Andrea Fuller, has an opening for a post-doctoral researcher to participate in fieldwork and coordinate data collection. The position will be for a year in the first instance, with the possibility of renewal, and the successful applicant will be based at one of two field stations in South Africa. It is essential that applicants have fieldwork experience, while a working knowledge of ecological physiology is highly recommended.
