

## German Beginners' Evening Classes

2017/1<sup>st</sup> Sem.

Requirements: These classes are offered for beginners; no prior knowledge of German is required. They are not credit bearing for South African students and do not lead to a qualification. No certificates are issued.

Duration: 2 classes of 90 minutes per week for one semester (36 hours)

Times: Tuesdays and Thursdays 17:30 – 19:00

Break: There will be no classes during the recess 8–17 April nor on public holidays.

Test: A test is written during the last class on Thursday 11 May.

### Generic Outcomes

To understand, speak, read and (to a lesser extent) write basic German in everyday situations and have a basic knowledge of contemporary German society.

### Specific outcomes

At the end of the semester, a student should be able to:

- talk about himself/herself, his/her life and surroundings, the weather, likes and dislikes and other basic conversational topics;
- understand simple basic texts;
- understand and react to a basic conversation in German ;
- listen to basic recordings in German (songs, announcements, weather report etc.) ;
- write a short letter or e-mail.
