

## **Spanish Beginners' Evening Classes**

**2018/1<sup>st</sup> Sem.**

Requirements: These classes are offered for beginners; no prior knowledge of Spanish is required. They are not credit bearing for South African students and do not lead to a qualification. No certificates are issued.

Duration: 2 classes of 90 minutes per week for one semester (36 hours)

Times: Tuesdays and Thursdays 18:30 – 20:00

Break: There will be no classes during the recess 30 March –8 April nor on public holidays.

Test: A test will be written during the last class on Thursday 17 May.

### **Generic outcomes**

To understand, speak, read and (to a lesser extent) write basic Spanish in everyday situations and have a basic knowledge of contemporary Spanish society.

### **Specific outcomes**

At the end of the semester, a student should be able to:

- talk about himself/herself, his/her life and surroundings, the weather, likes and dislikes and other basic conversational topics;
- understand simple basic texts;
- understand and react to a basic conversation in Spanish;
- listen to basic recordings in Spanish (songs, announcements, weather report etc.);
- write a short letter or e-mail.
