

The vegetation of South Africa, Lesotho and Swaziland

This book provides, for the first time, a detailed description of the vegetation of a region with amazingly high plant diversity by global standards. More than half of its plants are found naturally nowhere else on Earth. 440 Vegetation types are characterized and hierarchically grouped, with most of the types illustrated with full colour photographs. Information on the climate and conservation status of vegetation types has also been included. The atlas section maps the vegetation types at a scale of 1:1 000 000.

- ☞ The richest succulent flora of any arid zone in the world, with many strange plant adaptations

- ☞ The often impenetrable thickets of the Eastern Cape that hide many endemic plants
- ☞ Extensive central plateaux with waving grassland and ruggedly drought-adapted plants
- ☞ The myriad of small but diverse forests dotted through the eastern landscape
