

## THE APPLICATION PROCESS FOR PROSPECTIVE STUDENTS - 2012

1. Students phone US Enquiries **021 808 4515** and ask for a complete application information package or go to the US web page [www.sun.ac.za](http://www.sun.ac.za) and “click” on **Undergraduate Application form**. An application fee is applicable.(plus minus R150)
2. Application is open as of March.
3. For hostel accommodation application closes June 30<sup>th</sup>.
4. Application for university admission is accepted until September 30<sup>th</sup>, but without access to US accommodation.
5. Application for all under graduate programmes in Music closes September 30<sup>th</sup>.
6. Only if the Music courses are not yet full are such late applications (after September 30<sup>th</sup> until November 15<sup>th</sup>) still accepted for auditioning.
7. Compulsory **US Access tests** for **all** prospective **degree** students (regardless of their direction of study or their academic achievements) take place as from July – possible dates can be obtained from the US Administration at 021 808 4327. For the selection process of BMus students it is advised to take the access tests before auditioning.
8. **Diploma** and **Higher Certificate** students do not need to write the **US Access Tests**. For **Degree study**, students’ NSC achievement and the result of the US Access tests must, in a relation of 60:40, be an average of minimum **60%**.
9. For acceptance into the **Degree** programmes at **University**, applicants must have achieved an average pass mark of **50%** in **4** of the list of university accepted subjects.  
Applicants for the **Diploma** must be in possession of a National Senior Certificate with an average pass mark of **40-49%**.  
Applicants for the **Higher Certificate** need a **Matric Certificate**.
10. **After** a student has been provisionally accepted into the university he/she will be notified thereof as well as given the audition dates for all the undergraduate Music programmes and relevant information on the departmental selection process.
11. The student must now book an audition date (Aug 27<sup>th</sup>, Oct 7<sup>th</sup> or Nov 25<sup>th</sup>) with the programme coordinator at [mroux@sun.ac.za](mailto:mroux@sun.ac.za) and also so state his/her choice of main instrument and the music programme (i.e. Degree, Diploma or Certificate) for which he/she is applying.
12. At the auditions students automatically are considered for a number of Departmental Scholarships. Information with regards to other US Loans & Scholarships can be obtained from 021 808 4627.
