



Ronald D Sanderson Honours Bursary in Polymer Science 2023

The Department of Chemistry and Polymer Science is pleased to invite applications for the "Ronald D Sanderson Honours Bursar(y)ies in Polymer Science" for honours study in 2023.

This bursary fund has been created in collaboration with the South African Polymer Industry to provide financial support to students wishing to pursue their post-graduate studies in Polymer Science at the University of Stellenbosch. The bursary has been named after Prof Ron Sanderson in recognition of his more than 39 years' contribution to the development of polymer education in South Africa.

A number of bursaries up to a value of R 45 000 each are available for full time honours study in 2023. All 3rd year students who will be completing their BSc Degrees in Chemistry in 2022 may apply. The bursaries will be awarded on the basis of merit (academic excellence) as well as financial need. This bursary may be held in conjunction with other bursary awards. Only applicants who have applied to register for Polymer Science Honours in 2023 will be considered.
